WITHDRAWAL OF SUPERVISORY DESIGNATION

On November 30, 2023, the Director of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (Bureau) issued an order to designate World Acceptance Corporation (World Acceptance) for supervision.

World Acceptance is a nonbank company that offers installment loans. It is subject to supervision by State regulators.

The Bureau is shifting its supervisory priorities to focus on pressing threats to consumers. Among other changes, this includes prioritizing the largest depository institutions and deprioritizing areas where States have and exercise ample authority. Supervision of World Acceptance is not consistent with these priorities.

Accordingly, the order dated November 30, 2023 is hereby withdrawn.
